In 2010, she was selected by Governor Jay Nixon to serve on the Missouri Department of Economic Development's Steering Committee. Ora was inducted into the 2010 inaugural class of the Midwest Commercial Real Estate Hall of Fame and is a member of the *Kansas City Business Journal's* "Women Who Mean Business" Class of 2008.
